

Léonard Bôle Member of the Executive Board Head of Markets division

Léonard Bôle (1973) graduated in Law from the University of Freiburg in 1998 and went on to complete an LL.M. in Berlin. He was admitted to the bar of Canton Geneva in 2002. He developed his banking and management expertise in the Executive Program of the Swiss Finance Institute (2008).

In 2004 Léonard Bôle joined the Legal Services department of the Swiss Federal Banking Commission, working on a combination of supervisory proceedings, regulatory tasks and international affairs. Since the foundation of FINMA in 2009, Léonard Bôle has played a key role in developing in the competence centre for combating money laundering. He was also responsible for the supervision of self-regulatory organisations and directly supervised financial intermediaries (DSFIs). In 2011 he took on additional cross-sectoral responsibilities in the Markets division. In particular, he acted as chair of the committee which is responsible for licensing institutions. He also managed and provided expert support on important regulatory projects in the fields of money laundering and collective investment schemes. Léonard Bôle has been a member of the Executive Board since 1 April 2014.
