



Special requirements for the operation of insurance class B10: “motor vehicle liability”

Non life insurance

1. Legal requirements specific to this class of insurance

- Art. 4 par. 2 I, Art. 46 par. 1e, Art. 86 par. 1f Federal Insurance Supervision Law - ISL
- Art. 58-79e and 82 Road Traffic Law (RTL; SR 741.01);
- Transport Insurance Decree (TID; SR 741.31);

2. Legal requirements for authorisation to operate as a motor vehicle liability insurer

The application must cover the following points:

- Confirmation that the applicant is a member of the National Insurance Bureau and National Guarantee Fund in Switzerland.

- Name and address of the claims representative appointed by the applicant in each State that grants reciprocity to Switzerland in accordance to article 79e of the RTL (see List of countries which guarantee reciprocal rights, link).

When applying for approval to operate, the insurer must also apply for a company code from the Swiss insurance association. This code is required by the road traffic departments in individual cantons and is recorded in vehicle registration documents.
