



Dr. Eugen Haltiner
Chairman since 1 February 2006

Eugen Haltiner (1948) received his doctorate in Economics and Social Science from the University of Geneva in 1979. From 1973 until taking over the role as Chairman of the Swiss Federal Banking Commission, he worked for Union Bank of Switzerland and subsequently for UBS AG. He assumed his first management responsibilities for the bank in Central Accounting. After an assignment in international business in New York for several years, he served as a branch manager in the Swiss branch network. In 1993, as Managing Director and member of the Executive Board, he assumed responsibility for the Retail Products and Private Clients business area for Union Bank of Switzerland. Subsequent to the merger of Union Bank of Switzerland and Swiss Bank Corporation to form UBS AG, he headed up the integration of the business units in Switzerland in 1998. In 1999, as member of the Group Managing Board, he was appointed head of the Corporate Clients business area, which then joined with the Private Clients business area in Switzerland to form the Business Banking area. From February 2005 until his departure from UBS, Eugen Haltiner served as Vice-Chairman Business Banking. Eugen Haltiner is a colonel in the general staff (retired from service).
