



Charles Pictet

Commissioner since 1 January 2005

Charles Pictet (1945) has a degree in economics and social sciences from the University of St. Gallen. He joined Bank Pictet & Cie in 1969, becoming a partner ten years later. From 1996 until his appointment to the Swiss Federal Banking Commission (SFBC), he was senior partner at Pictet & Cie. From 1979 to 1988 Charles Pictet was also a member of the Swiss Federal Commission of the old age and survivors' insurance (OASI) and from 1992 to 1999 member of the Geneva Private Bankers Association. From 1996 to 2001 he was a member of the Committee of the Swiss Private Bankers Association and from 1996 to 2005 of the Board of directors of the Swiss Bankers Association. For over 20 years he was a member of *economiesuisse*, the umbrella organisation for the Swiss economy, serving as Vice Chairman from 1990 to 2003. Charles Pictet has been appointed commissioner of the SFBC as of 1 January 2005.
