Jean-Baptiste Zufferey (1960), Doctor in Law, LL.M. is a qualified attorney-at-law and, since 1994, has been a Professor in Public Law at the University of Fribourg, where he also obtained his degree, his PhD and his professorship. From 1995 to 1998, he taught by invitation at the University of Geneva. In 1997, he was appointed Director of the Institute for Swiss and International Construction Law, and since 1998, he has taught by invitation at the EPFL in Lausanne. He is active in the field of banking and financial law. From 1998 to 2000, he chaired the panel of experts “Integrated financial market supervision” set up by the Federal Department of Finance to monitor financial market supervision. Since 2003, he has been Vice President of the Swiss Federal Banking Commission (SFBC). Jean-Baptiste Zufferey is also a member of the Chamber of International Cooperation of the SFBC. He also chairs the annual Regulators’ Meeting at Bürgenstock.
