Simon Brönnimann (1981) has been Interim Head of the Banks division since 1 September 2025.

From 2024 to September 2025, Simon Brönnimann was responsible for the Supervision of Small Banks and Securities Firms section within FINMA. From 2015 to 2023, he headed the Supervision of UBS and the CS Group as well as the follow-up work in the wake of the Credit Suisse crisis. From 2013 to 2014, he was responsible for monitoring the UBS Group's risk function and the Retail and Corporate division. From 2007 to 2012, he oversaw the supervision of numerous banks within FINMA and its predecessor organisation. During this time, Simon Brönnimann also completed a secondment at the Monetary Authority of Singapore (MAS) and worked in FINMA's General Counsel's Office. Prior to this, he worked in the lending department of a Swiss regional bank and was an assistant in the Department of Economics at the University of Bern.

Simon Brönnimann holds a master's degree in Economics, has completed INSEAD's Transition to General Management programme and is a Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA). He gained his first experience in the financial sector during his banking apprenticeship.
